



## Uniball Bcn F7 Rules

These rules outline the framework for Uniball 7-side football events.

### 1. Penalty Shoot-outs

- a) If a playoff game ends in a draw (0-0 or 1-1 etc..), the game will go to run up style penalty shoot-outs. There will be 4 penalties per team, if the teams are still drawing, they will continue to take penalties until one team scores and the other misses.
- b) The penalty taker will start with the ball on the halfway line, the goalkeeper will start on the goal line. The penalty taker can then dribble forward to shoot or shoot directly, once the first touch is taken, the player has a maximum of 5 seconds to finish the play. Once the goalkeeper touches the ball the penalty taker cannot touch the ball again.

### 2. Red Cards

- a) Resulting from a direct red card (reserved for the most serious offenses). The receiving player being sent off and not allowed to return to the field for that match. It also prohibits the player from playing in the following match.
- b) Resulting from a double yellow card. The receiving player being sent off and not allowed to return to the field for that match. The player can play the next match.
- c) Depending on the gravity of the offense, subject to the discretion of the organization. The player receiving a red card may be subject to further disciplinary action.
- d) If a player receives a direct red card, their team will remain with one less player for the remainder of the game.
- e) If a player receives a red card as the result of two yellow cards, the team who has received the red card (double yellow) will be allowed to replace the suspended player immediately with a new player assuming they have a substitute. If the team does not have a replacement player the team will remain with one player less. This rule applies for all Championship fixtures.

### 3. Offside

- a) In all F7 fixtures, there is offside. This offside applies from the yellow line (the yellow line second closest to a teams own goal), not from halfway.

### 4. Disciplinary actions

- a) Uniball Bcn retains the ability to enforce disciplinary sanctions against participants who exhibit poor sportsmanship or otherwise violate the code of conduct, terms or conditions or any other rule applying to Uniball Bcn participants.
- b) Such disciplinary actions will be communicated to the respective captains of the team who are affected.

**5. Replacement Players (only for Championship events)**

- a) We understand that teams may at times have players who are absent or injured. Replacement players can participate only if they consent to all of Uniball Bcn's rules, including those outlined in this document, the Terms & Conditions, the Data Privacy Policy, the Code of Conduct and any other relevant document.
- b) Replacement players will have to pay a fee of €3 per match to the Uniball Bcn coordinators to cover the administrative cost of adding an extra player to the teams digital profile.

**6. Rule Change**

- a) Uniball Bcn retains the right to change the rules to improve the quality of sporting framework for all players.

**7. Running Subs**

- a) Ref doesn't need to be notified, incoming player(s) cannot enter until the exiting player leaves the field

**8. Playoffs**

- a) Extra time, two halves of 5 minutes each
- b). Replacement players, a player cannot be play for a team during playoffs is he has not played for that team during the regular season
